IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR VISIT

Please review and discuss the following with your students and chaperones prior to your visit.

Before Your Visit

- When possible, please make a preliminary visit to the exhibition so you will be familiar with it. Show your school ID to receive the school rate. Save your receipt as proof of payment and you will not be required to pay again.
- We have an exhibit guide for teachers available on our website, LynxExhibits.com.
- An “In-Exhibit Worksheet” is also available to download on our website. Please use this worksheet to keep your students focused and on-task during the visit.

Day of Visit

- **It is important that you arrive promptly at your scheduled reservation time to avoid confusion and delay.** Early arrivals will have to wait until their scheduled time to enter the exhibit. Late arrivals may also be charged general admission.
- Teachers and chaperones are responsible for group supervision during the entire visit.
- Please leave bags, backpacks, coats, etc. on the bus as we do not have a coat or bag check available and are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Large groups will be divided into smaller groups of 30-40 students. Please be prepared for this when you arrive.

Museum Etiquette

- **DO** enjoy your visit! It is fine to be enthusiastic and to talk about what you see, but please keep your voices reasonably low and be aware of others around you.
- **No running inside.** Please move carefully through the exhibit.
- No food, drink or chewing gum is allowed inside the exhibit. Please leave all water bottles and chewing gum on the school bus.

Visiting the Gift Shop

- Please plan on visiting the gift shop as part of your field trip. We have souvenir items to fit every budget, with prices starting at \$1.00.
- It is usually best if small groups of about 10 children at one time visit the gift shop with at least one adult chaperone.
- Any gift shop breakage must be paid for at the time of the mishap.
